KATHERINE LINTON RETURNS TO HOST THIS SEASON'S FINAL EPISODE

NEW YORK– August 31, 2007 – IN THE LIFE, America’s longest running – and three–time Emmy–nominated – gay and lesbian national newsmagazine, prepares to air its 15TH season’s final episode: “Moving Forward, Looking Back” (#1612). As part of its long–anticipated makeover, IN THE LIFE will also give viewers a lighthearted “sneak–peak” at the audition tapes for some of the potential faces to host its upcoming season.

As the first LGBT–focused national television program, IN THE LIFE will have a familiar face hosting this season’s final episode: Katherine Linton. As a longtime producer and former host from 1993–2000, Linton will return in October for IN THE LIFE’s season premiere to introduce the new host. “It’s been such an honor being associated with this program, and a part of its history,” said Linton. She added, “It’s so critical for our community to be reminded of the challenges we’ve faced together and won.”

In this episode, viewers will be shown stories, including, an interview with the director, and the lead actor of Desert Hearts—the highest grossing lesbian film of–all–time, celebrating its 20TH anniversary; a look into the life and work of influential playwright, Christopher Durang; and the story of HIV–positive Lorenzo Taylor, who was denied entry into the Foreign Service, and – in–turn – filed suit against the U.S. Department of State and Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice.
